## A) Tithes and Christian Giving

"Satan would like the church's mission to be nonexistent – he is super happy with empty pews and empty baptistries – he is fine with under funding for the poor – he is just fine with budget cuts and layoffs for church staff. He smiles when churches can no longer keep their doors open because there is no money."

### Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-8 and then answer the following questions:

2 Cor 9:6-8 Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

- 3. Explain your understanding of sowing and reaping and how it applies to giving to the Lord. Do you think you only reap in heaven or does it also extend to this life?
- 4. What parts of the process of investing in your 401K and stocks seem to parallel the practice of Christian giving?
- 5. With all the financial pressures we find ourselves under, it's natural to have feelings of reluctance and anxiety about giving to the Lord. If you are reluctant, should you "not give" until you start feeling "cheerful" about it? What things can you remind yourself of to change the way you feel about giving?
- 6. List a number of the benefits that come to people who become a generous giving person?

### B) Overcoming Debt

### Read this out loud

An excerpt from the message this week:

"Have you noticed how easy it is to get into debt – it is so easy to charge things on our card – in a matter of seconds we can hit the limit on one card – and start in on the next card. Average American has 4 credit cards. It is easy to get a credit card – I got one once at the PHX Open because you could get a free T–shirt if you signed up for one – so I did. I got a free T-shirt. When I got home Linda made me call and cancel the credit card before I could do anything else.



Debt is our way of being impatient. We don't want to wait. Rather than feeding the pig – putting money in savings – we go into debt – and we justify it. I deserve this much needed vacation. I need a new truck."

### Read Proverbs 22:7, the following and then answer the following questions:

Prov 22:7 The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is slave to the lender.

- 7. With so many people struggling with debt today, what strategies have you seen to be effective for people in getting out of debt?
- 8. Do you tend to be more of a spender or a saver? What have you found are the benefits and the problems with that style of handling money?
- 9. What are you currently doing to switch from being in debt to investing for your future here on earth and investing in the Kingdom of God.
